## Domenico Bianchi *New Works*

Slewe Gallery is pleased to announce the opening of the exhibition with new works by Italian artist **Domenico Bianchi** (\*1955). The opening of the exhibition will be Saturday May 28 between 6 and 8 pm. The show will run until July 2, 2016.

Bianchi is known for his paintings made with his own developed technique of mixing wax and oil paint, sometimes combined with Palladium leaf. His images with a perpetuum mobile motive derive from computer program stills. The exhibition will show some new works on paper in addition to some works on wood and some small silver works.

Work by Bianchi will also be on view at the exhibition *Excitement* at the Stedelijk Museum Amsterdam, curated by Rudi Fuchs, from May 27 through October 2, 2016.

Bianchi, born in 1955, lives and works in Rome. He studied at Fine Art Academy in Rome. His career started in 1977 with his first solo show at Ugo Ferranti in New York. In the eighties he became known as one of the emerging artists of the so-called La Nuova Scuola Romana and exhibited his work alongside Arte Povera artists such as Kounellis and Mario Merz. He had his first show in the Netherlands at Riekje Swart in 1980. Several European museums made solo shows of his work, such as at the Stedelijk Museum in 1994, and at MACRO in Rome in 2003. He participated in several Venice Biennials, in 1993 as a solo artist. Since 1998 he shows regularly at Christian Stein in Milan. Slewe Gallery shows his work since 2009.
